

## Creating an effective poster!

## Things to remember

- Make sure the poster can be read from a distance.
- Ensure it has some white space so as to be more readable.
- Use fonts and colours that are easy to read. You may wish to use your business's corporate colours.
- Only use one or two fonts. Give emphasis by bolding or making slightly larger.
- Try to keep the design and colours of all your poster consistent. Having a template will also save you time.
- Break your poster up into columns with short facts or actions. Our brains are wired to store information in manageable bits so we can recall then when needed.
